1 DAY 1: JESUS
 Jesus told a story about a lost sheep (Luke 15:4-7).
Can you find five lost sheep on this map?
 In the story the shepherd searched everywhere for the sheep until he found it. The story is really about how much we are loved by God, and how precious we all are to Him. We can talk to God about everything, especially what makes us happy and what makes us sad. We can ask God to help us. Can you draw five people you love in the circles below and ask God to help them too?

2 DAY 2: PRAISE
 What makes you go 'Wow'? Write some things below.
 A song in the Bible says that "God has done amazing things for us!" (Psalm 126:3) Every "wow" moment can be a gift from God when we realise it's from Him.
 Click keypad 2 in the TKC AR app to watch a video about saying "wow" to God for the amazing things He has done. Did you like the pandas in the video?
Can you find five hidden pandas on this map?
 Pray for your five people: "Jesus, help my friend see the amazing things that come from you."

3 DAY 3: THANKS
 Find 5 hidden treasure chests on this map.
 What do you "treasure"? Toys, family, pets, holidays? Write or draw some things below.
 The Bible says that every good gift comes from God (James 1:17). We can thank God for all the treasures in our lives. You can pray or say out loud the treasures that are in the space above, and after each one say, "thank you God!" People are even more precious than things, so treasure your five people.

4 DAY 4: SORRY
 One day a woman came to Jesus. She knew she had done a lot of wrong things, but Jesus loved and forgave her. In response, this woman poured out the greatest treasure she owned - a huge bottle of expensive perfume - all over Jesus' feet.
Can you find five perfume bottles on the map?
 We all do wrong things sometimes. Is there anything you think you should say sorry for today? When we come to Jesus He always forgives us and welcomes us to be with Him, just like He did with the woman in the story.
 You can pray today by saying "Sorry God for _____". After saying sorry, your group or family can respond by reminding you "Jesus forgives you!" You can also pray that your five people know they can be forgiven by God.

5 DAY 5: OFFER
 There are times we might feel like we have little to offer the world. Our talents and strengths can feel small when we compare ourselves to others or look at the needs all around us. Paul, one of Jesus' followers, said that Christians are like clay jars with the treasure of Jesus inside us.
Can you find 5 clay jars on this map?
 Back in those days people used simple clay jars to keep basic food in. If you had treasure, you would keep it in a more beautiful, expensive, sturdy container. But God puts his treasure in ordinary people like us. And that means we have a lot to offer! Think about the needs of people around you, and especially any needs your five people might have. Are there one or two simple ways you can offer what you have to help meet those needs? It might be your time, your kindness, a simple gift or something else.

8 DAY 8: ADORE
 Jesus told a story where someone found a precious treasure in a field (Matthew 13:44). That person went and sold everything to have that treasure - they made the treasure the most important 'thing' in their life.
 Lots of people seem to treasure 'things' the most - money, houses, jobs, gadgets. The best thing we can treasure and love is God, because He can be trusted to take care of our hearts. Making God number one in our hearts means we adore Him.
Can you find five hearts on this map?

6 DAY 6: PRAY FOR
 Jesus met a man called Zacchaeus, who was hiding up a tree. **Can you find five Zacchaeuses up trees on this map?**
 You've been seeking treasure on this map. The other people thought Zacchaeus wasn't that special, but Jesus thought he was worth going out of his way to find because He "came to seek and to save the lost."
 Pray for your 5 people, something like: "Jesus, may _____ know that you think they are precious treasure worth seeking and saving."

11 DAY 11: PENTECOST
 After Jesus had gone back to heaven, His friends were scared and didn't know what to do next. But then came a day called Pentecost, when God's Holy Spirit filled them (Acts 2:1-4). The Holy Spirit looked like flames of fire on people's heads. **Can you find 5 people on the map with fire on their heads?**
 When they were filled with the Spirit, Jesus' friends started speaking boldly about Him, and doing all the things he had taught them.
 The greatest treasure we can find is Jesus. The Holy Spirit can give us the boldness to share this treasure with our friends.
 Today you can pray: "Holy Spirit, fill me up, help me be bold for Jesus!"

10 DAY 10: SILENCE
 In the Bible it says that wise people gather knowledge, which is a true treasure, but know-it-alls talk too much (Proverbs 10:14 The Message version). Do you ever find yourself talking a lot, rather than listening? Are you surrounded with the noise of phones, TV, games and other distractions?
Find the five phones on this page.
 Being quiet and still helps us calm down and listen for God's still, small voice. Sometimes it can help to turn off our technology, finish our conversation and just sit quietly for a minute or two. Try that for your prayer today - sit quietly for one minute, and just enjoy being still in God's presence.

9 DAY 9: CELEBRATE
 Jesus told another story about a woman who found a lost coin. She invited all her friends and neighbours to come and celebrate with her (Luke 15:8-10).
Can you find five lost coins on the map?
 In the Bible, people are called lost when they don't know Jesus. Jesus wants to find us and everybody who is lost, even when they don't feel lost. Think about the five people you are praying for. Every time one of them takes a step closer to Jesus, it is a reason to celebrate, to have a party, to thank God and be happy.
 Pray today by putting on some worship music and singing along to celebrate God. You might even want to dance!

7 DAY 7: HELP
 Jesus told a story about a man who was beaten up on a dangerous road, and needed some help (Luke 10:30-37). **Can you find 5 hurt people on your map?**
 Who do you know that needs help? Write or draw some people or situations in the space below where you could be a help to someone.
 Pray that God would give you courage to offer help where it is needed. You can stand in a super-hero pose, and pray something like: "God, make me bold, brave and kind to help those in need". You can also pray that you might be a help to your 5 people.
