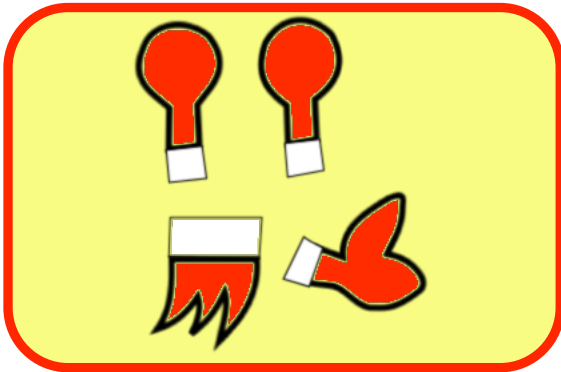


INSTRUCTIONS

Stone Sea Creatures

You will need: acrylic paint/poster paint mixed with PVA glue, brushes, paper/card, scissors, PVA glue, coloured pens/pencils, black permanent marker

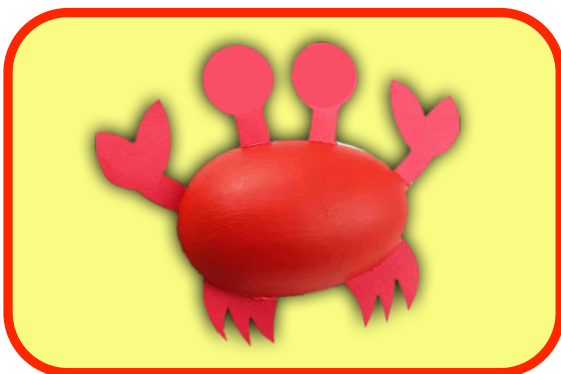
CRAB



Print and colour in the template for the crab in red. Carefully cut out the pieces and fold the tabs.



Paint the stone red and let it dry completely.



Stick the template pieces to the front of your stone (only the front is seen when placed on a surface or held).



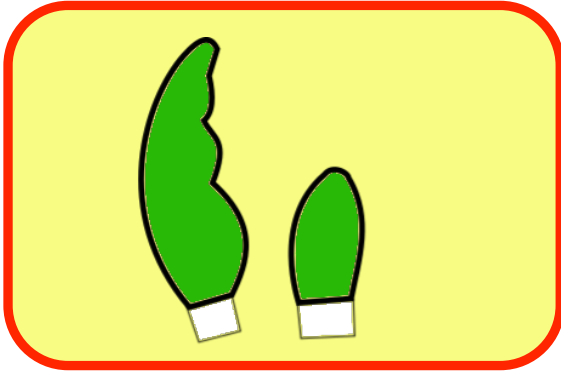
Draw the details on your stone and template pieces.

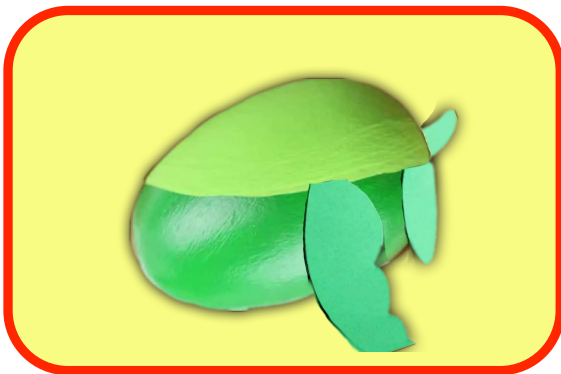
Turtle



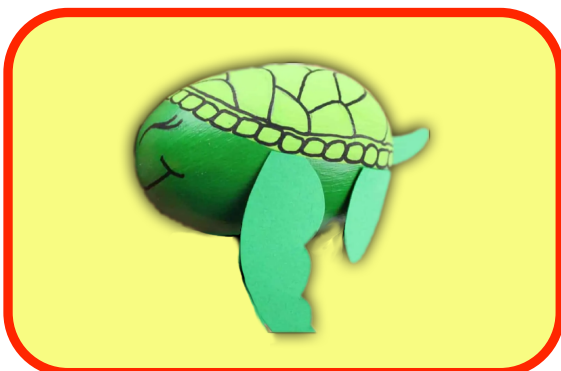
Print and colour in the template for the turtle in dark green. Carefully cut out the pieces and fold the tabs.



Paint the stone dark and let it dry completely, and then paint the shell area in light green and let that dry.



Stick the template pieces to the front of your stone (only the front is seen when placed on a surface or held).



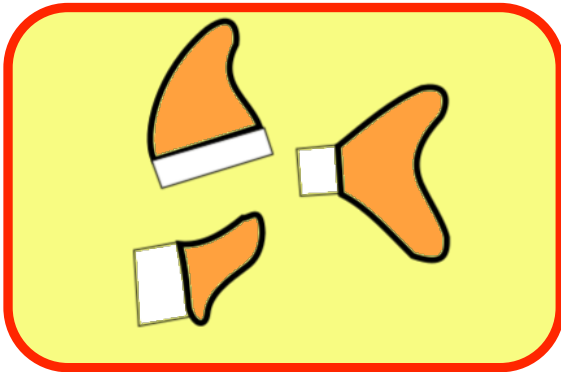
Draw the details on your stone and template pieces.

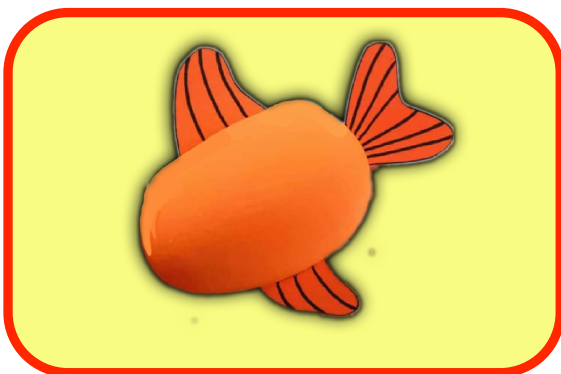
Tropical Fish



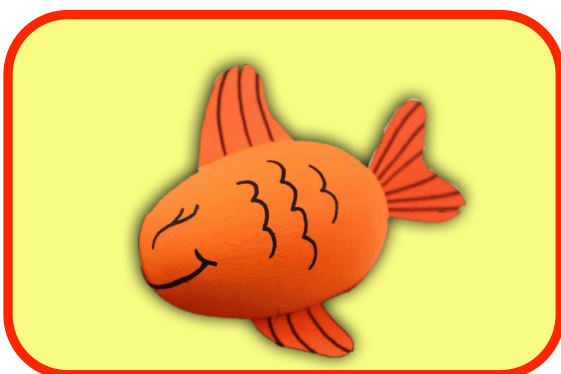
Print and colour in the template for the tropical fish in orange. Carefully cut out the pieces and fold the tabs.



Paint the stone orange and let it dry completely.



Stick the template pieces to the front of your stone (only the front is seen when placed on a surface or held).



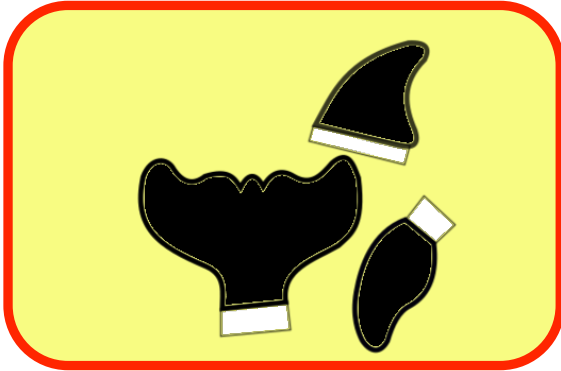
Draw the details on your stone and template pieces.

Orca



Print and colour in the template for the orca in black. Carefully cut out the pieces and fold the tabs.



Paint the stone black and let it dry completely, and then paint the belly white and a white spot. Let it dry.



Stick the template pieces to the front of your stone (only the front is seen when placed on a surface or held).



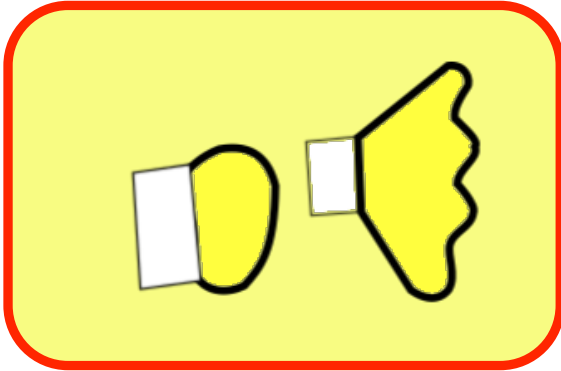
Draw the details on your stone and template pieces.

Puffer Fish



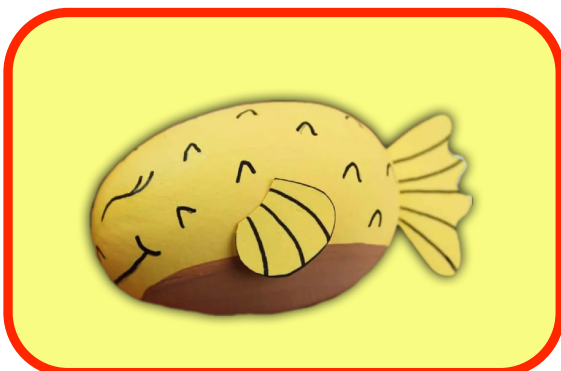
Print and colour in the template for the puffer fish in yellow. Carefully cut out the pieces and fold the tabs.



Paint the stone yellow and let it dry completely, then paint the belly light brown and let it dry.



Stick the template pieces to the front of your stone (only the front is seen when placed on a surface or held).



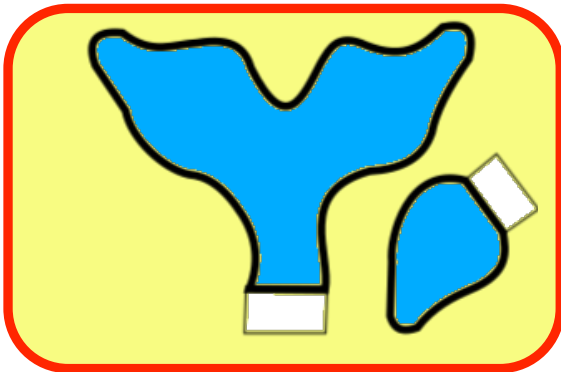
Draw the details on your stone and template pieces.

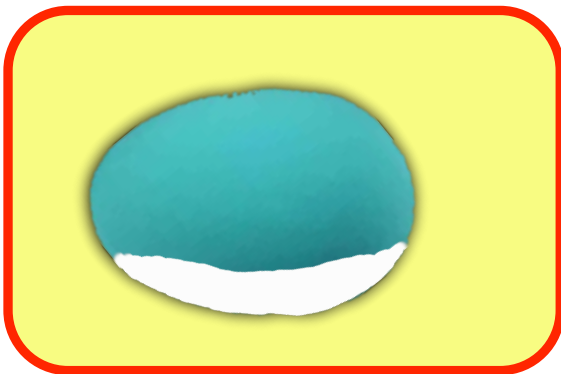

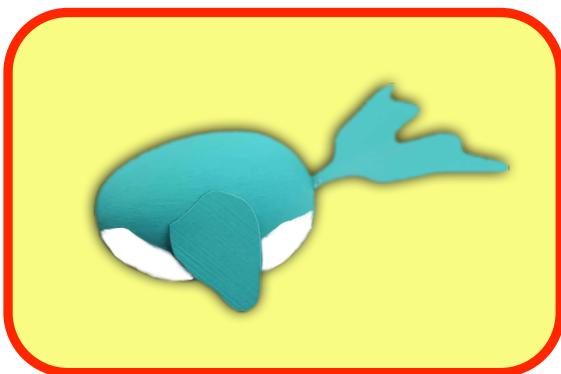
Blue Whale



Print and colour in the template for the blue whale in blue. Carefully cut out the pieces and fold the tabs.



Paint the stone blue and let it dry completely. Then paint the belly white and let it dry.



Stick the template pieces to the front of your stone (only the front is seen when placed on a surface or held).



Draw the details on your stone and template pieces.
