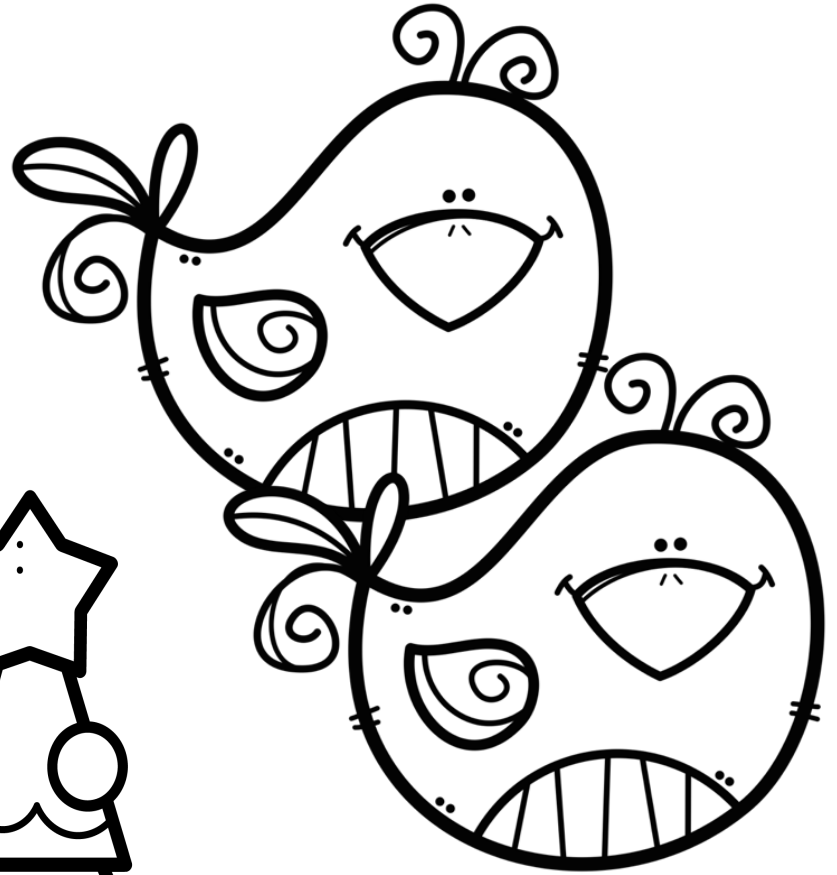

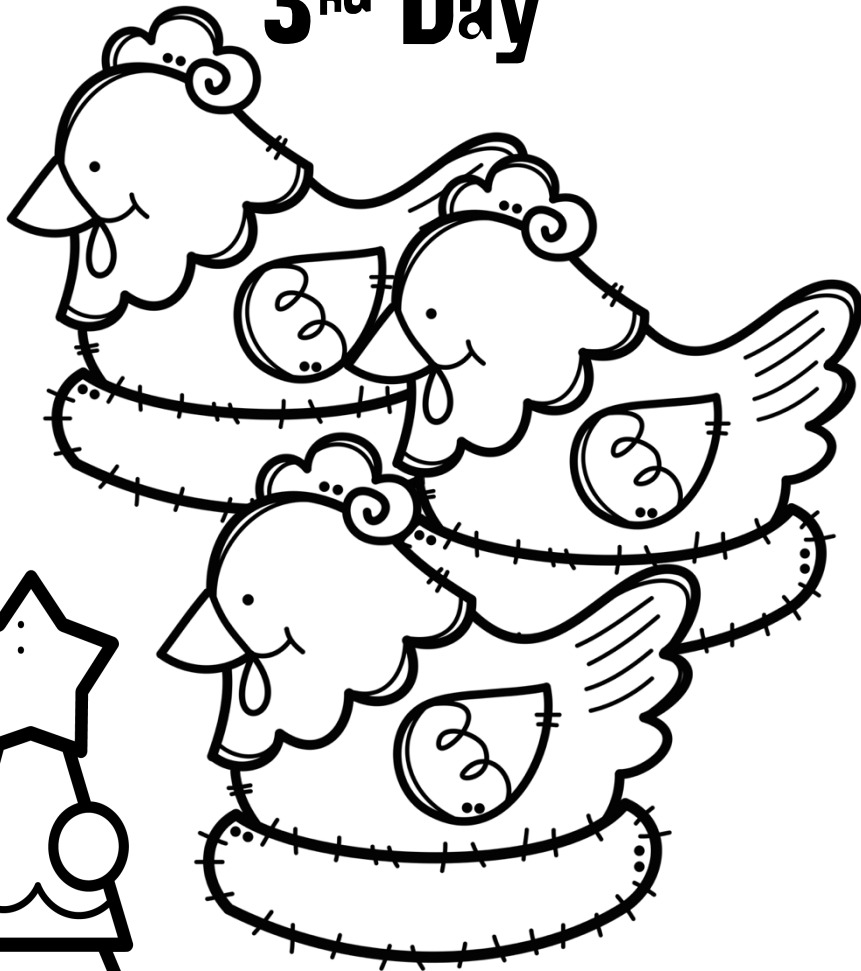

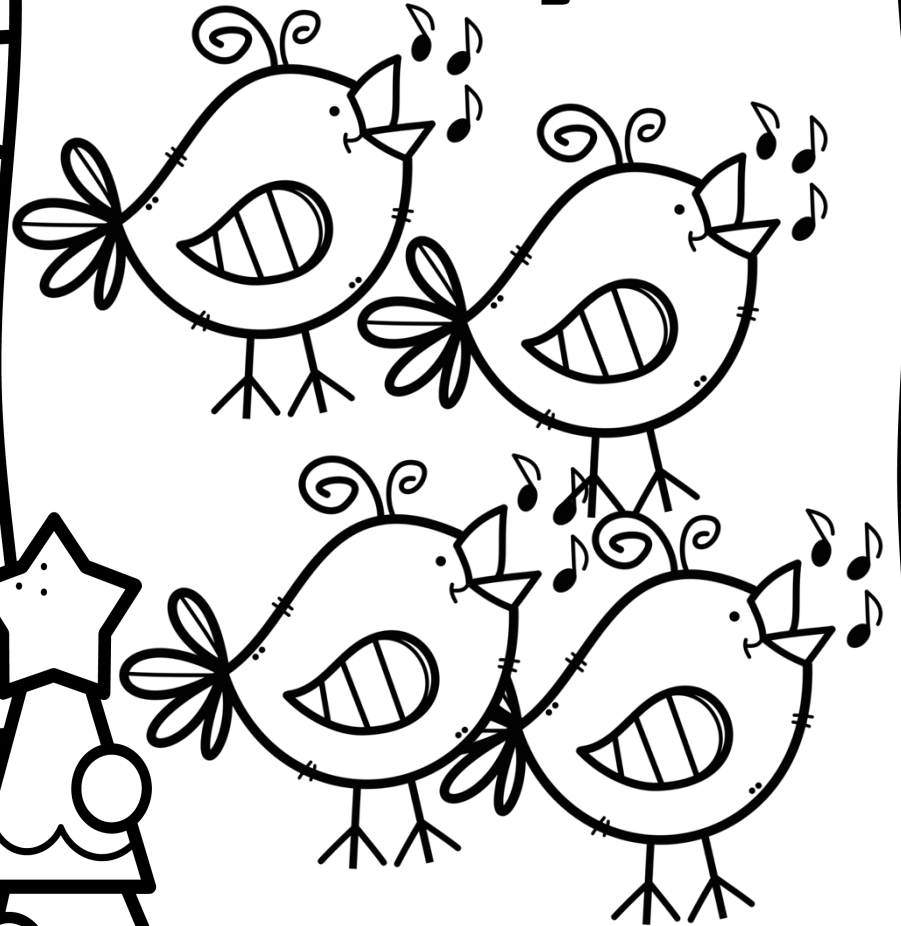
**The Two Turtle doves

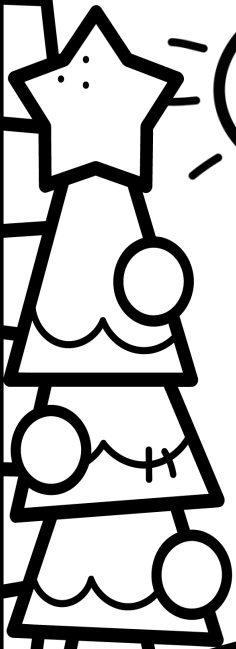
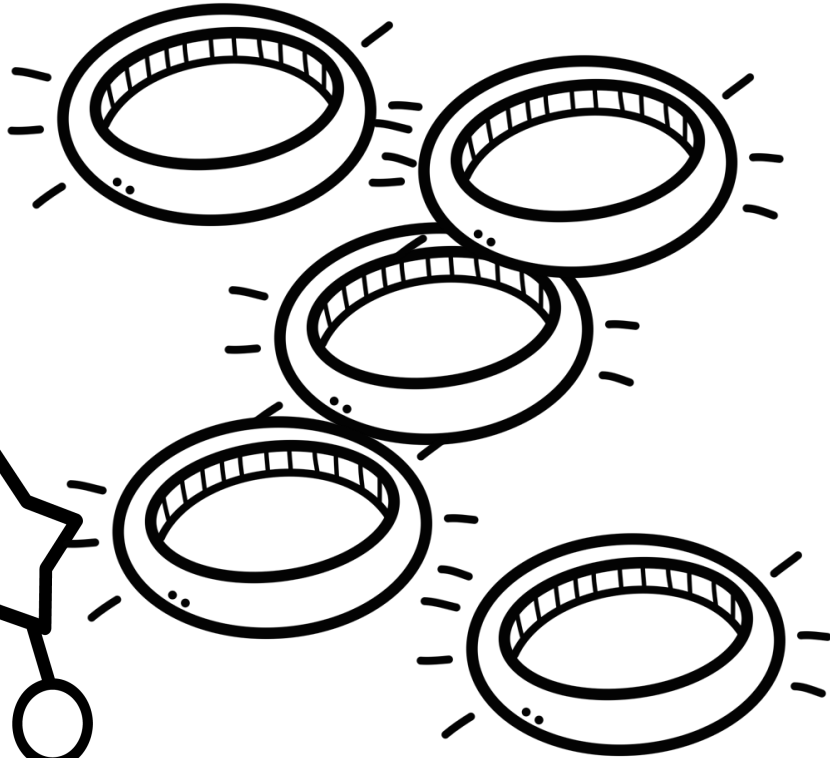
The Three French hens

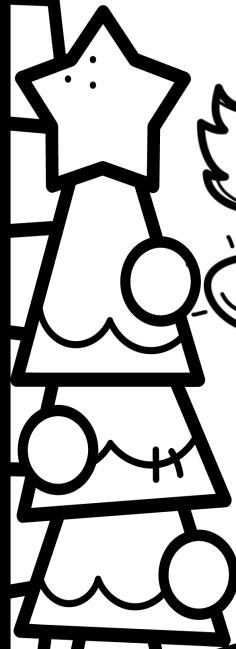
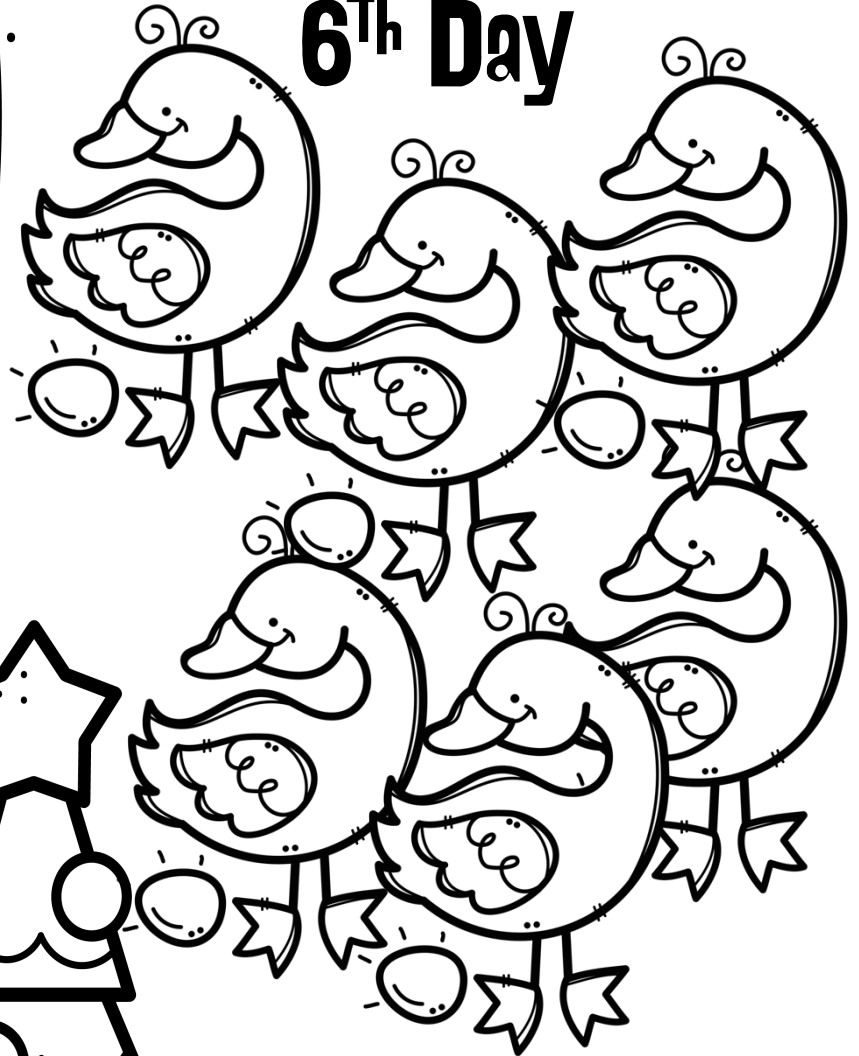
The four calling birds

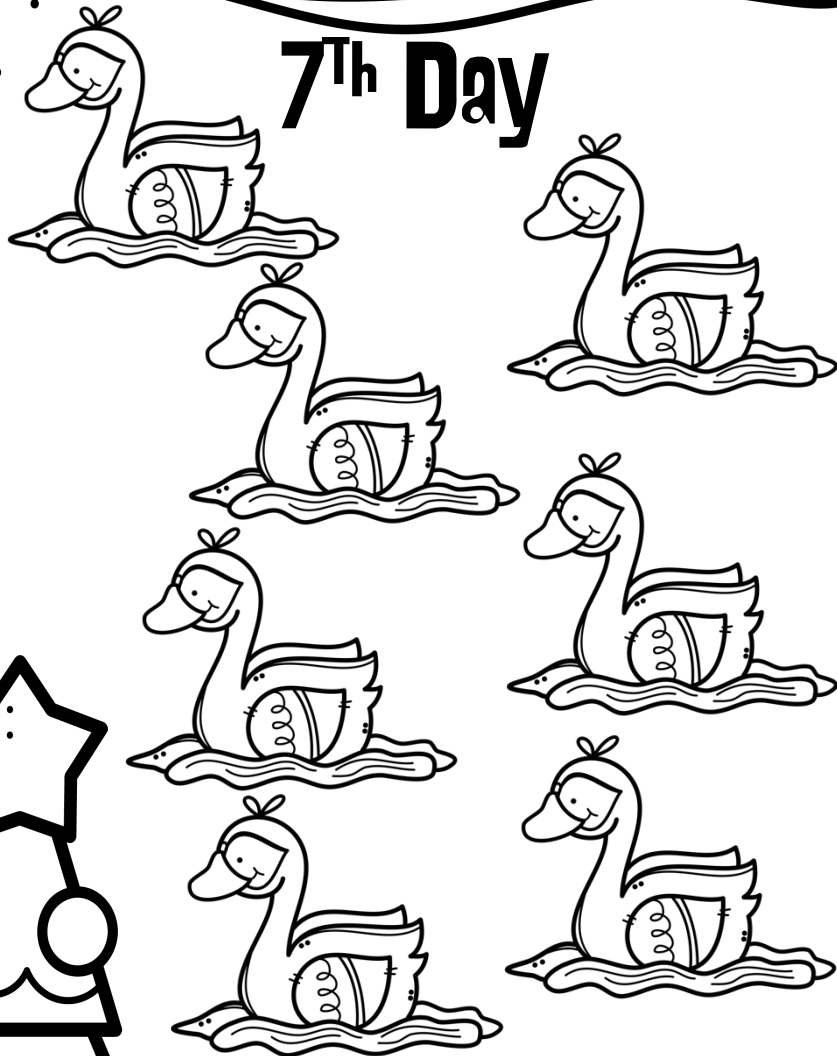
The five Gold rings represent

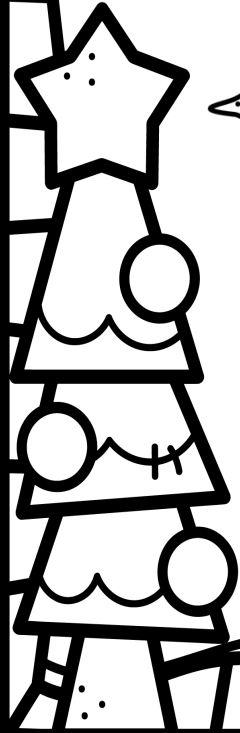


The six Geese a-laying

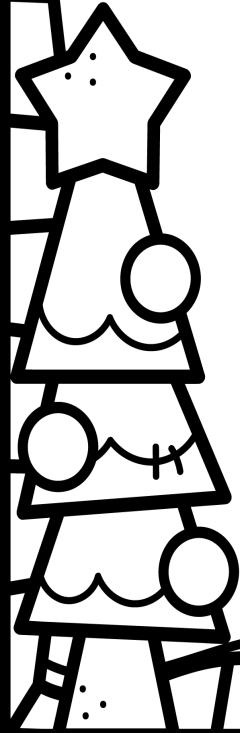
The seven swans a-swimming

The Holy Spirit.



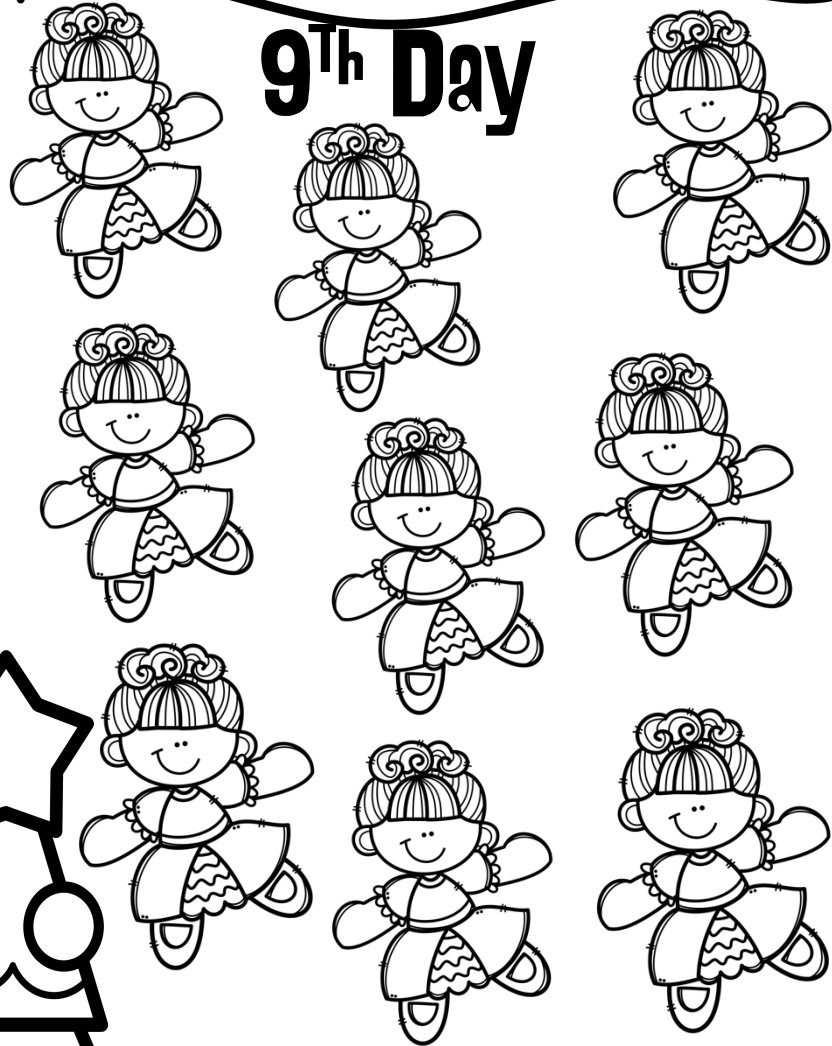
8th Day

9th Day



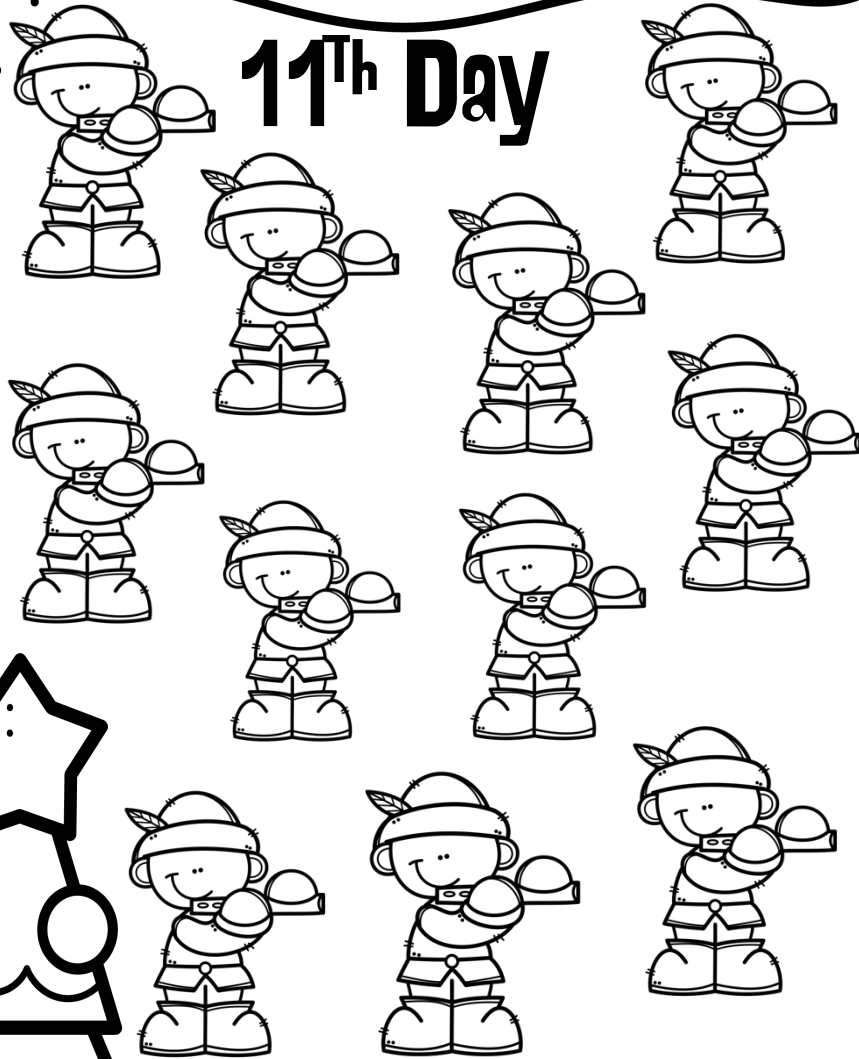
The nine Ladies dancing

10th Day



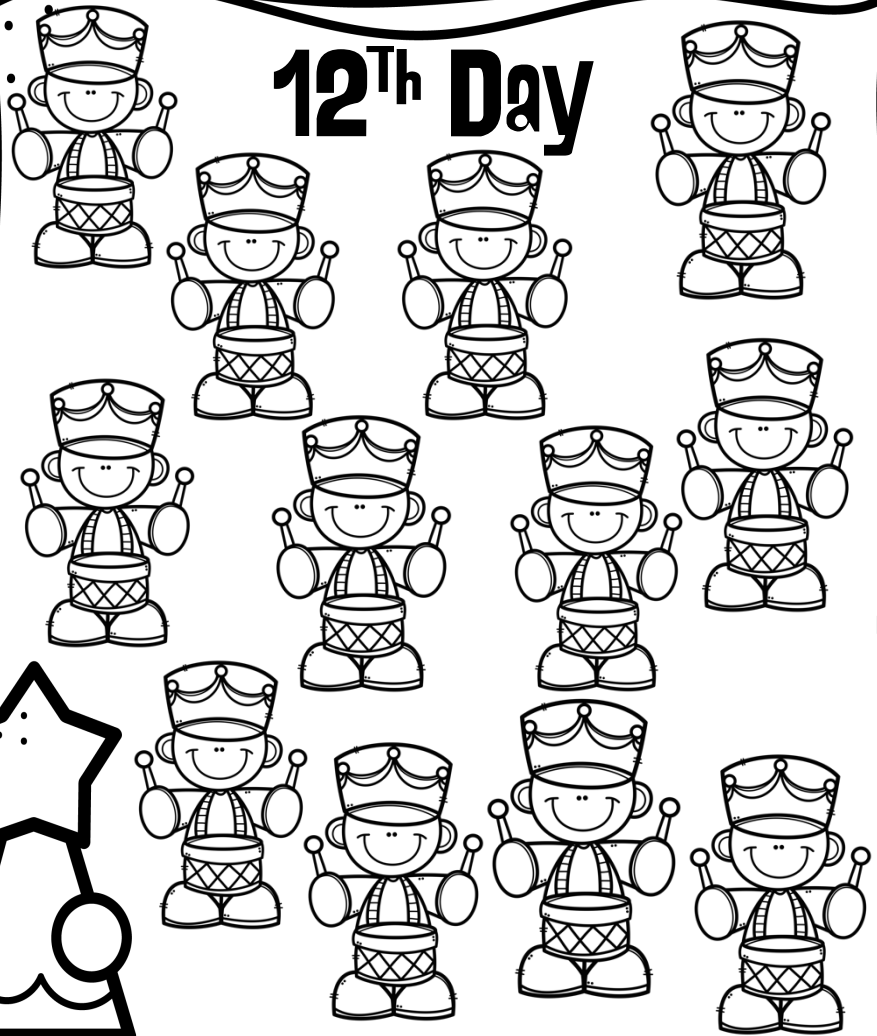
The Ten Lords a-Leaping
